By successfully completing the lifeguarding course you will be eligible to be a lifeguard at the Recreation Center indoor and/or outdoor pools! The lifeguarding course includes First Aide and CPR training. Students need to bring suit and towel each day. There will be a lunch break each day. There will be a 10 student maximum and 5 student minimum for this class. March 16—March 18.

Pre-requisites for Lifeguarding

- 1.) Be at least 15 years of age on May 26, 2020
- 2.) Swim 300 yards (6 lengths in our pool) continuously, using the strokes in the following order:
- 100 yards of front crawl using rhythmic breathing (performed either by breathing to side or front) and a stabilizing, propellant kick
- 100 yards of breaststroke
- The last 100 yards may be a mix: front crawl/breast stroke

***If you are unable to meet these pre-requisites, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
